Tata Main Hospital

Tata Main Hospital is the iconic hospital of Tata Steel, established in 1908 catering to the needs of Tata Steel employees, their families, and the citizens of Jamshedpur. It is a 983-bedded hospital with all the basic and tertiary care facilities in eight super specialties i.e., Cardiology, Gastroenterology, Neurology, Nephrology, Neurosurgery, Urology, Plastic Surgery and Surgical Oncology. This hospital also houses facility to conduct renal transplant and Bone Marrow Transplant. The hospital has been accredited for ISO 9001:2008 and NABH Certification. Our pathology laboratory is the first hospital based NABL accredited unit in Jharkhand.

College of Nursing

Nursing training program in Tata Main Hospital started with General Nursing & Midwifery course in 1939 and the students passed out of this institute are present all over the globe. School of Nursing was upgraded in 2015 to impart Basic B.Sc. Nursing Degree under the aegis of Kolhan University, Chaibasa. The course covers everything from best practices in routine care to intensive care and patient safety and patient care in various specialties. College started offering M.Sc. Nursing course from 2023 onwards to bridge the gap of post graduate nurses for managerial and educator roles.

Course Description

The M.Sc. Nursing course is a two year post graduate course which is designed to empower nursing graduates with advanced knowledge and skills in different domains of nursing practices including leadership and research as envisioned in National Health Policy,2002. During study, graduates undergo rigorous competence building in their chosen specialty at

different healthcare setting alongside regular classroom instruction in subjects such as Advanced Nursing Practice, Nursing Education, Nursing Research & Statistics and Nursing Management. Daily attendance in College is imperative and Internal assessment are carried out to ensure attainment of course objectives throughout the course. University examination is conducted annually on completion of course requirements for that particular year. Annual Intake in College of Nursing, Tata Main Hospital is ten (10) in four (04) different clinical specialties. Seat Distribution for each Speciality Subject is as follows.

Course Objective

On completion of this course, students will be able to

1. Apply different concepts of nursing sciences into their professional life at clinical and educational setting.
2. Demonstrate advanced competence in practise of nursing in their own specialty.
3. Function effectively and efficiently as leader in their area of practise.
4. Collaborate with other healthcare professionals to achieve cross functional goals.
5. Conduct research to improve the standard of care in their relevant field.
6. Decide on continuing education needs for self, team and organization to support professional development.
7. Plan future requirements proactively and elevate the standard of nursing profession in times to come.

Eligibility Criteria /Admission Requirements

1. Female candidates are eligible to apply for the course in College of Nursing, TMH.
2. Candidate should have passed Basic B.Sc. Nursing/B.Sc. Hons. Nursing/Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing with minimum of 55% aggregate marks. 5% relaxation of marks for SC/ST candidates is applicable.
3. The candidate should have a valid registration as a Registered Nurse and Registered midwife or equivalent with any State Nursing Registration Council.

4. The candidate should have undergone in B.Sc. Nursing / B.Sc. Hons. Nursing / Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing in an institution which is recognized by Indian Nursing Council.
5. Minimum one year of work experience after registration as Registered Nurse & Registered Midwife as on last date of submission of application form for candidates with Basic B.Sc. Nursing.
6. Minimum one year of work experience after registration as Registered Nurse & Registered Midwife as on last date of submission of application form prior or after Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing (P.B.B.Sc. Nursing).
7. The upper age limit for candidates shall be 45 years of age as 31st of December of the year of admission. Age relaxation norm will be applicable for scheduled category.
8. Candidate shall be medically fit.
9. Inservice candidates should obtain “No Objection Certificate” from the employer.

Note:

- a. Simultaneous attendance in other courses is not permitted.
- b. The candidates qualifying P.B.B.Sc. (Nursing) from Madhya Pradesh Bhoj University through distance education are not eligible for M.Sc. (Nursing) program as resolved by Indian Nursing Council
- c. The candidates qualifying P.B.B.Sc.(Nursing) from IGNOU through distance education are not eligible for M.Sc. (Nursing) program if the study centre is not recognized by Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi.

Selection Procedure

- All eligible candidates must appear and clear the written test conducted by competent authority (JNRC). Further details are to be checked in www.jnrc.com
- Candidates securing pass marks will be called for a personal interview.
- The selected candidates will be offered to join the programme subject to their being found medically fit from TMH.

Leave During Course

All students are entitled for 4 weeks of vacation in each year which they can avail according to the discretion of the managing authority of the College. All students are entitled for 15 days of institutional holidays in a calendar year. Student is not entitled for any sick leave during study period as per Indian Nursing Council regulations. However, for any medical reasons, students will be allowed leave on certification by an authorized medical practitioner of Tata Main Hospital. Sickness certified other than Tata Main Hospital will be treated as absenteeism. Sick leave beyond 7 days will be adjusted against their annual leave.

Employment Opportunities

On completion of the M.Sc. Nursing program, Tata Main Hospital or College of Nursing does not guarantee any employment in TMH. All students will receive a valid Post Graduate Degree Certificate from Kolhan University, Chaibasa and a Registration Certificate by Jharkhand Nurses Registration Council, Ranchi.
